TRC STRATEGY

The TRC has evolved a strategy of allowing (ex-) terrorists amnesty, even though their crimes had nothing whatsoever to do with politics, while important opponents of the ANC/Communist group are denied amnesty on any pretext.

For example, the assassination of the head of the Communist party is regarded as not being political by the ANC (says Dullah Omar), because "Chris Hani was a civilian".

This includes Clive Derby-Lewis and Janusz Walus, who have recently been refused amnesty by the courts, after their KGB-type show-trial by the so-called "Truth And

The Amy Biehl Case.

This was the most notorious amnesty decision made, and became highly controversial. Miss Biehl, an American, was simply killed by APLA terrorists because she was white. She was not part of any "oppressive" regime! In a hearing lasting two days, amnesty was granted to her killers within 12 months after the beginning of their amnesty hearing.

Clive Derby-Lewis and Janusz Walus submitted their amnesty applications in June 1996. Their hearing took 23 days, over four sessions, and the decision to refuse them amnesty was only made known nearly TWO

Reconciliation Commission" and their one-sided "Amnesty Committee". The latter refused amnesty to many political prisoners, who remain in prison while the country goes to pot under Communist rule..

The St James Church Massacre.

The most glaring inconsistencies abound concerning amnesty decisions. The perpetrators of the St. James Church massacre, where black terrorists slew a multiracial group of churchgoers (including some Russian seamen) simply because the church was located in a mainly white residential area! These terrorists were granted amnesty despite the fact that they had been convicted on 11 counts of murder and 58 counts of attempted murder. Their application was submitted in 1997 and their amnesties granted within 11 months of their original amnesty hearing. Their hearing lasted just two days.

In another incident, a group of terrorists shot up the Heidelberg Tavern, where four people were killed. These terrorists were also convicted on 7 cases of attempted murder and two counts of robbery. Their hearing lasted five days, and they were granted amnesty six months after their hearing commenced.

YEARS later.

Despite the fact that amnesty legislation specifically states that priority attention must be given to those in prison, this rule was not applied and many who were not in prison were handled before Derby-Lewis and Walus' hearing was held.

The path to freedom via the politically subservient courts is obviously closed. Yet other options are clearly available which heretofore were not, because they might prejudice the court case.
